Don't Ditch that Dead Desktop

This month Susan and I set out four dead desktop computers for the trash collectors. Afterwards the thought came to me, "What a waste. There's got to be at least one good use for NWF ("not worth fixing") PCs. Here are several ideas I quickly brainstormed.
