### DID YOU KNOW? - PART 2

Although I’ve gone through the rules & regulations many, many times, I still found some I didn’t remember seeing despite the fact they were always there. There’s always something new!

1. No subleasing/renting is permitted for periods of less than 2 months. All tenants and occupants must obtain a criminal background check through the park office.
2. Each mobile home in the park must bear a current annual license.
3. All accessory buildings and/or modifications on a mobile home must receive approval from the park. (Always check with the office before starting work on additions, modifications or renovations.)
4. No trees may be removed without prior approval by the park.
5. No fences of any type are permitted in the park except for trash and recycling enclosures.
6. No bamboo, reed, matchstick, or other type of hanging shall be used on or around a patio. Canvas is also not permitted.
7. The park must approve the color of any driveway that is to be painted, which can only be a sand tone color. (O\_O)

On Monday, September 2nd BLE will host our annual Labor Day lunch, at 1:00 p.m. courtesy of ELS Corp and our HOA. Always looking for volunteers. Thus far Michael Kloian & Brad Bixbee are the committee members.

Look for the sign-up sheet at the clubhouse by August 1st. The sign-up sheet will be pulled by August 25th so we may plan and purchase the food items in time for Labor Day.

The menu will be a variety of gourmet grilled cheese sandwiches, tomato soup, kosher pickle spears and individual bags of chips.

Starting with the traditional grilled cheese with white American cheese; then white American cheese, tomato with fresh cooked bacon; white American cheese & sliced heirloom tomatoes; ham & Swiss cheese; sliced turkey with melted French brie cheese, apple butter & arugula (like last year); (new) Italian with salami, pepperoni slices & provolone cheese on rye bread; Patty melt (cooked burgers) on grilled rye bread with white American cheese & caramelized onions. Ketchup (for the patty melts) & mustard will be available. Ice tea and deserts.

We plan to cut each sandwich in half and wrap them in the insulated foil wrap so our residents can try 2 different sandwiches, if they choose to do so.

## Grandparent and Family Scams

**Here's how they work:**

You get a call: "Grandma, I need money for bail." Or maybe an email from someone claiming to be your brother or a friend who says they're in trouble. They need money for a medical bill. Or some other kind of emergency. The caller says it's urgent — and tells you to **keep it a secret.**

But is the caller who you think it is? Scammers are good at pretending to be someone they're not. They can be convincing: **sometimes using information from social networking sites**, or hacking into your loved one's email account, all to make it seem more real. And they'll pressure you to send money before you have time to think.

**Here's what to do:**

1. **Stop.** Check it out. Look up your family member's phone number yourself and **call another family member** to check out the story.
2. **Pass this information on to a friend.** You may not have gotten one of these calls, but chances are, you know someone who will get one — if they haven't already.

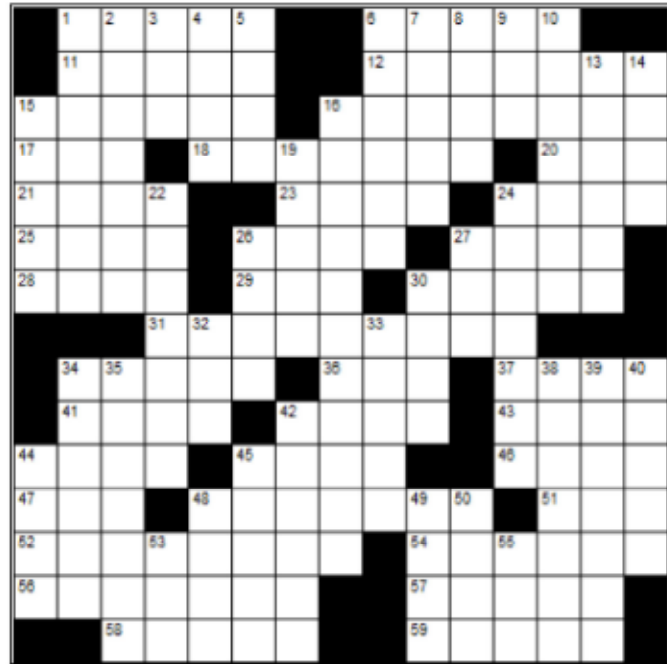
