WHY WE CELEBRATE ST. PATRICK'S DAY

After he arrived, Patrick became interested in Christianity and started teaching others about the religion. He is said to have converted many of the country's residents to Christians, and now St. Patrick's Day is celebrated on the day Patrick supposedly died.



Every year on March 17, the world turns a little greener—literally! From parades packed with leprechauns to rivers dyed emerald, **St. Patrick's Day** is a celebration like no other. But beyond the shamrocks, **green attire**, and pints of Guinness, there's a rich history behind this beloved holiday. So, before all the fun **St. Patrick's Day traditions**, why not take the time to learn about the history of St. Patrick's Day? There's more to it than you may think!

Take the patron saint of Ireland, for example. Did you know he wasn't actually Irish? (Cue the gasps!) Or that **St. Patrick's Day parades in the U.S.** were originally a means for early Irish immigrants to show their collective pride? The events even attracted hopeful political candidates vying for the Irish-American voting block. You'll also be shocked to know that many meals made to celebrate the day in America aren't actually **traditional Irish dishes**.

But if you're interested in why we celebrate in the first place, take a quick journey into the history of this popular holiday. Ahead, you'll find the actual reason behind St. Patrick's Day, information on Saint Patrick himself, and why we associate the color green with the day. You'll also find ideas to help you celebrate in the most traditional way. Sláinte!

You're probably not surprised to learn that St. Patrick's Day hasn't always been a raucous affair, celebrated with huge parades and green beer. As the feast day of Saint Patrick, it was and still is a holy day in Christianity. The day was **first established**

in 1631 as a modest religious holiday, and honoring Ireland's patron saint. Because it fell right in the middle of Lent, people began using it as a reason to celebrate and take a break from the restraints and abstinence of the period leading up to Easter. However, it didn't actually become a public holiday in Ireland **until 1904!**

The St. Patrick's Day celebrations we recognize today are actually a product of Irish immigrants in America. Parades sprung up in major U.S. cities in the 1700s, including Boston and New York City. As Irish populations grew in America, so did St. Patrick's Day festivities. During the 1900s, Americans on March 17 were wearing green clothes, eating corned beef and cabbage (despite it not being a popular dish in Ireland!), and attending massive parades across the country.

Yes, what started as a religious feast in Ireland has transformed into a worldwide celebration of Irish heritage, complete with lively parades that include bagpipes and plenty of shamrock-covered revelers. Of course, Dublin, Ireland, has an extravagant multi-day St. Patrick's Day Festival, featuring a parade, performances, and other events which attracts more than half a million spectators each year. It began in the 1920s as a military parade, shifted to a more standard procession in the 1970s, then became a full-blown party in the mid-1990s.

Here in the U.S., New York's St. Patrick's Day parade is actually known as the world's oldest and largest parade. According to **History.com**, it was started by in the 1760s by a group of Irishmen serving in the British army in New York City. Chicago's tradition of dyeing part of the Chicago River green has also become a popular St. Patrick's Day attraction. They even have three parade processions across the city. You can also find plenty of revelers celebrating in Savannah, Boston, Philadelphia, as well as Dublin in California and Ohio.

Saint Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland, known for bringing Christianity to the country. He lived in the fifth century and was actually born in Roman Britain—not Ireland! When he was 16, he was captured by Irish raiders and was sent as a slave to present-day Northern Ireland where he became a shepherd, **writes the BBC**. He grew close to his Christian faith during these difficult years and then went on and spread Christianity to the Irish through baptism and confirmation.



Hundreds of years after his death, several legends became popularized about this religious figure. One of these includes the famous story of St. Patrick driving the snakes from Ireland. But the explanation for there being no snakes in Ireland is simply that there's **never been snakes in Ireland!**

Editor's note... I lived in Savannah, GA for 7 years and I did attend the St. Patrick's Day parade twice during that time. The Savannah parade is the 2nd largest parade in the USA with about one million people in attendance.

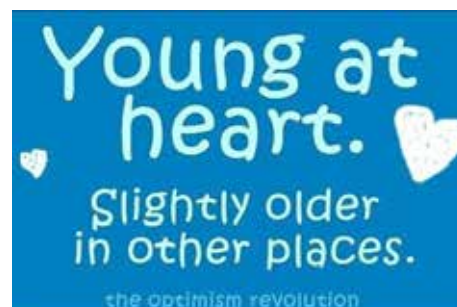

Do you think that your spouse is yelling at you more often than usual? If you said yes, you are not alone in this. We recently had George come in and asked for adjustments to his hearing aids. I asked why and he said, "my wife is yelling at me morning and night."

I must have looked confused so he explained. He said, "When I last saw you I remember getting coffee in the morning and my wife came in with a booming voice asking me something. I told her I heard her and she didn't need to yell. She laughed and said something like well there's a first time for everything. This morning she said something to me and I missed it. Then she looked me right in the eyes and said loudly, "Go ask Blair to help you.. and me."

I didn't need to adjust his hearing aids in the way he was thinking. I didn't need to make them louder. I just needed to do a cleaning. The skin debris and wax particles will clog both the speaker and the mic screen. If the mic isn't taking in sounds then he can't catch what his wife said. Or if the speaker is clogged then no sound can be transmitted at a volume you can hear, then she will need to yell.

ALERT

Grandparent and Family Scams

Here's how they work:

You get a call: "Grandma, **I need money** for bail." Or maybe an email from someone claiming to be your brother or a friend who says they're in trouble. They need money for a medical bill. Or some other kind of emergency. The caller says it's urgent — and tells you to **keep it a secret**.

But is the caller who you think it is? Scammers are good at pretending to be someone they're not. They can be convincing: **sometimes using information from social networking sites**, or hacking into your loved one's email account, all to make it seem more real. And they'll pressure you to send money before you have time to think.

Here's what to do:

1. **Stop.** Check it out. Look up your family member's phone number yourself and **call another family member** to check out the story.
2. **Pass this information on to a friend.** You may not have gotten one of these calls, but chances are, you know someone who will get one — if they haven't already.

NEW TRASH SCHEDULE

Trash Cart Transition Schedule

The new green trash carts have been delivered to the Bay Lake homes. Here are some of the key dates concerning their use, as provided by Sarasota County.

Key Dates

March 28, 2025	Last day of the current trash collection service
March 31, 2025	Service for the new trash cans begins
April 1, 2025	Bay Lake collection day is changed to Tuesday. 4/1/2025 is our first scheduled Tuesday trash pick-up day.
June 2025	Information about exchanging your cart for a different sized cart will be posted online at scgov.net/freshstartwithacart
July 1, 2025	You can exchange your cart for one of a different size beginning this day.

REMEMBERING 9/11

A program aired on 60 Minutes on November 17th regarding all those who perished when the Twin Towers collapsed, killing thousands. Well, unbeknown to most of us there is a handful of scientists and medical professionals who have taken on the daunting task of matching DNA from the relics they've collected from that horrific day. The DNA has revealed and has identified two people as of November 17th 2024. 1,103 remains were uncovered with about a 40% success rate. March's Featured Author - Frank McCourt

Taken from Irish Central Newsletters
In Frank McCourt's Pulitzer Prize-winning memoir "Angela's Ashes", he observed that the miserable Irish childhood is the only kind worth having. The success of this "epic of woe" propelled him from obscurity to fame and fortune at 66 years old.

McCourt was Brooklyn-born who returned to Ireland during the Depression when he was 4 years old, then later emigrated to the United States at the age of 19. He spent 30 years teaching English and creative writing in the New York public school system.

For the first generation children of Irish immigrants, there was common ground of universal experiences and strictly observed rituals. It's a different world now, but here are some signs that you were raised by Irish parents:

- * In any crisis large or small, the first thing to say is "Jesus, Mary, and Joseph".
- * One of your grandparents has a sibling who was either a priest or a nun.
- * Guinness isn't just for pints, it makes good stew and cake, too.
- * You are distantly related to every other Irish person (except the bollix over there making an eejit of himself).

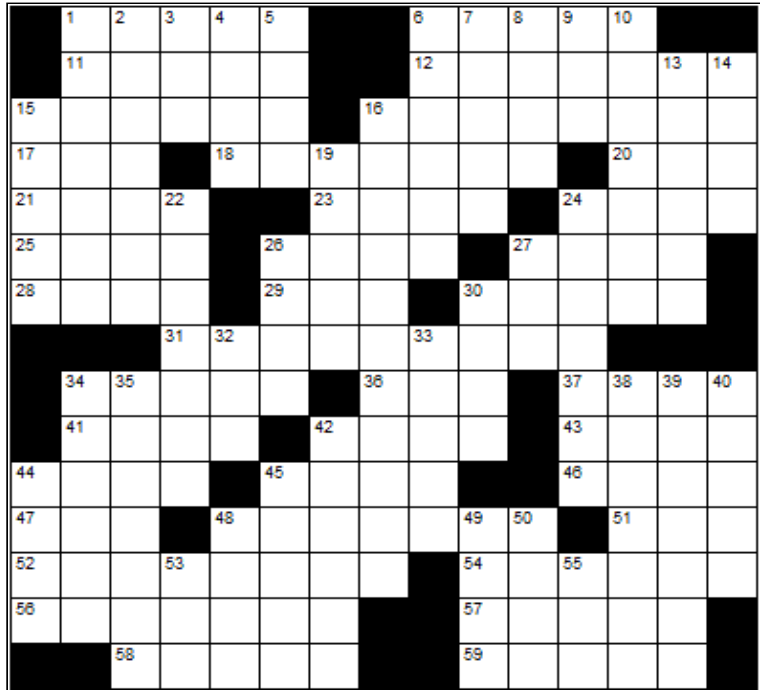
