
THE BURNING OF THE NOTRE-DAME CATHEDRAL – De PARIS

(con't from the February issue)
On April 15, 2019, at 18:18
CEST, a structural fire broke out
in the roof space of Notre-Dame
de Paris, a medieval Catholic
cathedral in Paris, France.



The fire, which investigators believe was started by a cigarette

or an electrical short circuit, destroyed the <u>cathedral</u>'s <u>wooden spire (flèche)</u> and most of the wooden roof and severely damaged the cathedral's upper walls. The <u>vaulted</u> stone ceiling largely contained the burning roof as it collapsed, preventing extensive damage to the interior. Many works of art and religious relics were moved to safety, but others suffered smoke damage, and some of the exterior art was damaged or destroyed. The cathedral's <u>altar</u>, two <u>pipe organs</u>, and three 13th-century <u>rose windows</u> suffered little or no damage. Three emergency workers were injured. The fire contaminated the site



The cathedral was closed immediately. Two days after the blaze, French president Emmanuel Macron set a five-year deadline to restore it. Notre-Dame did not hold a Christmas Mass in 2019 for the

first time since 1803. By September 2021, donors had contributed over €840 million to the rebuilding effort.

More than 400 firefighters were engaged; another hundred government workers moved precious objects to safety via <u>a human chain</u> also including police and municipal workers.

The fire was primarily fought from inside the structure, which was more dangerous for personnel but reduced potential damage to the cathedral;

applying water from outside risked deflecting flames and hot gases (at temperatures up to 800 °C or 1500 °F) inwards. Deluge guns were used at lower-than-usual pressures to minimize damage to the cathedral and its contents, with water that was supplied by pump-boat from the Seine.

Aerial firefighting was not used because water dropped from heights could have caused structural damage, and heated stone can crack if suddenly cooled. Helicopters were not used because of dangerous <u>updrafts</u>, but <u>drones</u> were used for visual and <u>thermal imaging</u>, and robots were used for visual imaging and directing water streams. Molten lead falling from the roof posed a special hazard for firefighters.

Shortly before the spire fell, the fire had spread to the wooden framework inside the north tower, which supported eight very



large bells. Had the bells fallen, it was thought that the damage done as they fell could have collapsed the north tower and then the south tower, and with them the entire cathedral. At 20:30, firefighters abandoned attempts to extinguish the roof and concentrated on saving the towers. Despite the risk of being caught in a collapse, a firefighter squad volunteered to attempt to put out the fire in the north tower, fighting from within and between the towers. Fourth Arrondissement Mayor Ariel Weil stated "At that point, it was clear that some firefighters were going to go into the cathedral without knowing if they would come back out." By 21:45 the fire was under control.

The <u>cathedral reopened</u> on 7 December 2024 after three years of reconstruction.

Editors note: I watched a special that aired on TV 12/01 regarding the reconstruction of the new roof and those who built the structure held fast to the original type of construction, ensuring that the Cathedral would last hundreds of years to come.

Getting yelled at?

Do you think that your spouse is yelling at you more often than usual? If you said yes, you are not alone in this. We recently had George come in and asked for adjustments to his hearing aids. I asked why and he said, "my wife is yelling at me morning and night."

I must have looked confused so he explained. He said, "When I last saw you I remember getting coffee in the morning and my wife came in with a booming voice asking me something. I told her I heard her and she didn't need to yell. She laughed and said something like well there's a first time for everything. This morning she said something to me and I missed it. Then she looked me right in the eyes and said loudly, "Go ask Blair to help you.. and me."

I didn't need to adjust his hearing aids in the way he was thinking. I didn't need to make them louder. I just needed to do a cleaning. The skin debris and wax particles will clog both the speaker and the mic screen. If the mic isn't taking in sounds then he can't catch what his wife said. Or if the speaker is clogged then no sound can be transmitted at a volume you can hear, then she will need to yell.

If you feel like everyone is yelling at you, or you are the one yelling. Please know that we can help make talking to each other easier. Call for an appointment to determine if the hearing aids need a cleaning, repair or service.





THE ELIZABETH DOLE FOUNDATION -THE DOLE FOUNDATION FOR THE SEVERLY DISABLED FOR SUFFERING VETS

Senator Elizabeth Dole's list of achievements demonstrates her lifelong commitment to service, made even more impressive by the fact that she was among the first, if not the first, woman to hold her positions. The following list is what her foundation is doing to change people's lives.

Dole is the first woman appointed as the U.S. Secretary of Transportation.

A native of Salisbury, North Carolina, Elizabeth Dole graduated with distinction from Duke University as a member of Phi Beta Kappa, and earned a law degree from Harvard Law School, and a Master of Arts in Teaching from Harvard University. She served as Deputy to the Special Assistant for Consumer Affairs during the Nixon Administration, launching a career of dedication to public safety, for which she received the Humanitarian Award from the National Commission Against Drunk Driving and the Lifetime Achievement Award from Advocates for Highway and Auto Safety. She was selected for induction into the Safety and Health Hall of Fame International for her transportation, workplace, and blood safety accomplishments. In the fall of 2012, the National Safety Council presented her the "Flame of Life Award" as one of the century's foremost leaders on safety.

Elizabeth Dole was only the second woman to serve as President of the American Red Cross, founded by Clara Barton in 1881. She restructured the world's largest humanitarian organization during her eight years as president, serving as a volunteer in her first year. She led a massive transformation of the way the Red Cross collects, tests, and distributes one-half of the nation's blood supply, to ensure that blood is safe to give and safe to get. Following the Red Cross, she sought the Republican presidential nomination, becoming the first viable female candidate from a major political party. Elected in 2002, Senator Dole became the first woman to represent North Carolina in the United States Senate.

Throughout her career, she has strived to help women and minorities reach their full potential. In her words:

"I believe in the innate goodness of the American people. I believe in the values that made this country what it is—courage, perseverance, generosity, faith, and a commitment to service."


